

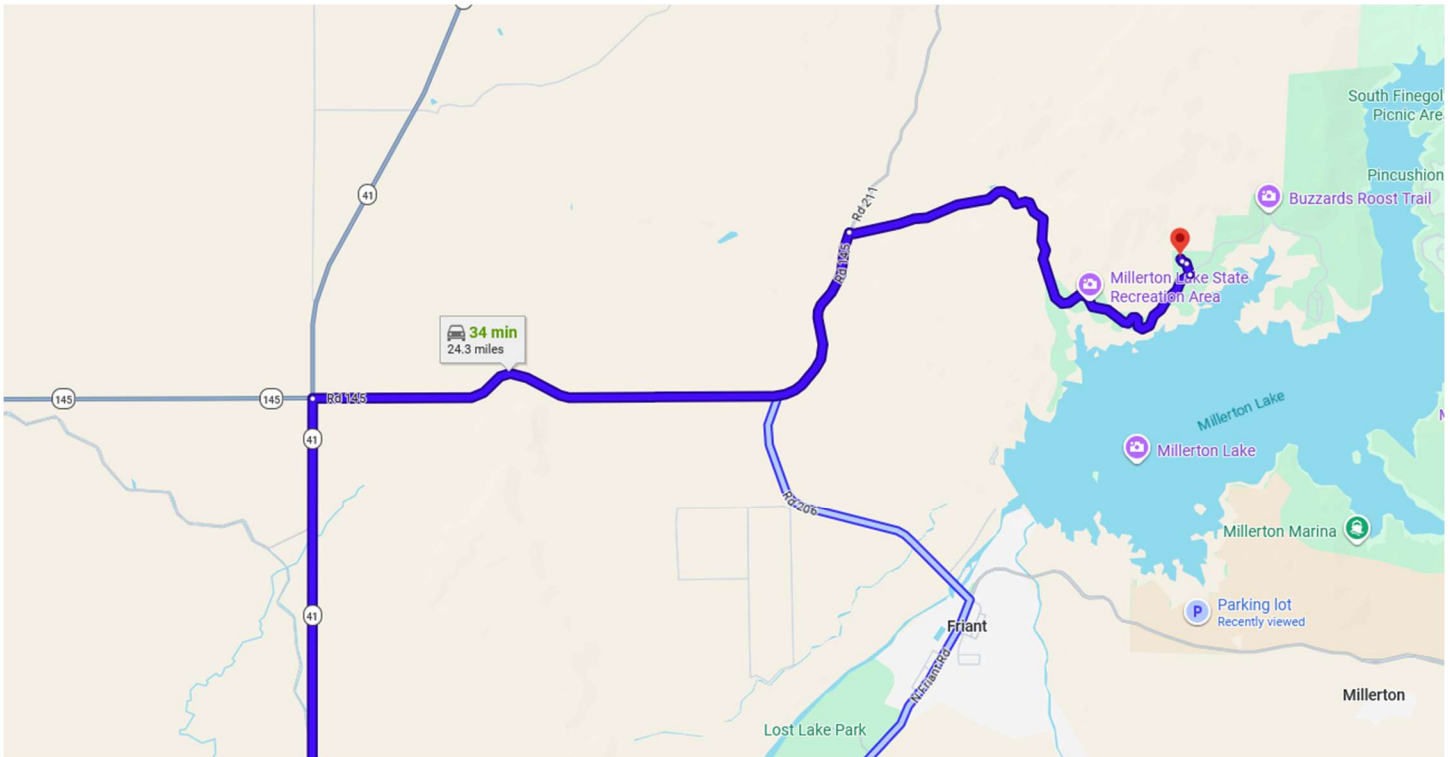
# Cub Scout Pack 75

### Millerton Lake - Large Group Campground (North Shore)

Search Google Maps for “Millerton Large Group Campground” for exact directions.



#### Driving Directions:

- Take CA-41 N, 14 miles from Shaw Ave.
- Turn Right onto Road 145, travel 3.25 miles.
- Bear Left to stay on Road 145, travel 1.3 miles.
- Turn Right (This one is easy to miss) to stay on Road 145, travel 1.3 miles to the Entrance Station.
- DO NOT PAY FEES AT THE ENTRANCE STATION. If greeted by a ranger at the entrance station, state you are camping in the Large Group Campground.
- From the Entrance Station, travel another 0.8 miles. Turn Left into the Group Campground area (Brown sign for ‘Group Camps’ and ‘Campfire Center’)
- Look for Pack 75 Flag

## Temperatures:

Highs in the high 60s-70s. Lows in the 40s-50s

## Event:

Though we hope all choose to camp, for anyone coming for the day Saturday, Scouting activities begin at 9:30 AM with the flag ceremony. Class “A” uniforms for the opening flag ceremony.

## Fee:

\$20 per person whether camping 1-2 nights or attending for the day Saturday. Fees cover the campsite cost, pack equipment, meals, and activities.

# CAMPING WITH SCOUTS – BASIC GROUND RULES

## Camping Dos:

- Stay with your families, dens, or buddies at all times
- Alert leaders to allergies or other important medical needs (medications etc.)
- Alert a leader immediately if injury occurs
- “Leave no Trace”
- Be considerate of other campers
- Leave your tablets or portable gaming devices at home and enjoy the great outdoors; minimal adult cell phone usage, please
- Webelos and Arrow of Light Scouts may assist in campfire building, knife use, and stove cooking
- Keep camp looking nice

## Camping Don'ts:

- DON'T enter the tent of another family
- DON'T enter another group's camp without permission
- DON'T bring a pocketknife, if you are under 18 and have not completed the rank specific knife safety adventure.
- DON'T touch or throw anything into the campfire
- DON'T bring fireworks or firearms of any kind
- DON'T bring alcohol – anywhere, anytime, per Scouting America regulations
- DON'T smoke within the vicinity or sight of any Scout, per Scouting America regulations

Cub Scout Camping is intended to be a fun, enjoyable experience to introduce Cub Scouts and families to the fun of camping and the outdoors. Have fun!

# CUB SCOUT PACK CAMPOUT – WHAT TO PACK

## General:

- Tent
- Sleeping bag
- Ground mat/air mattress
- Pillows
- Extra blankets for cold nights
- Camp chairs
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- Insect repellent
- Day pack or equivalent for hike
- Sun protection/lip balm

## For Meals:

- Refillable water bottle. Drinking water is available in camp.
- Adults may wish to bring a personal coffee mug. There will be coffee.
- Adults have personal coffee preferences. Bring your own coffee additives/creamers, sweetener (Disposable plates, bowls, hot cups and utensils will be provided)

## Clothing:

- Personal clothing for 40-50 degree nights and 60-70 degree days.
- Warm jacket
- Closed-toe shoes
- Class A Scout uniform
- Class B uniform
- Work gloves

## Other/Optional:

- Fishing pole and tackle if you have it. There will be free time.
- Football, frisbee, playing cards, or other free-time games.
- Quarters. The Group Campsites have coin-operated showers. QUARTERS ONLY. \$0.50 for the first 2 minutes. \$0.25 each additional minute.

## Reminders:

Scouts may carry a pocketknife ONLY if they have completed their rank specific knife safety adventure THIS ACTIVITY YEAR.
